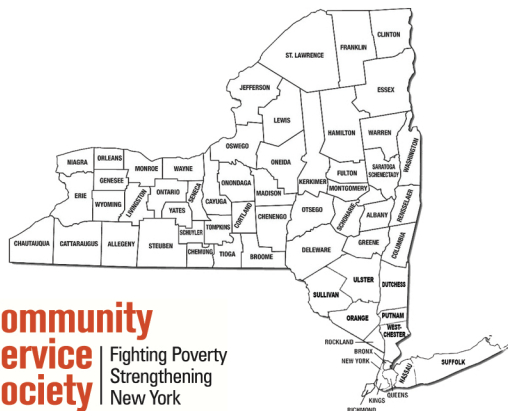

businesses so they can
provide health insurance to
their employees

ACA prevents insurance
companies from denying
services to their members for
a pre-existing condition
